## Our Mission — Our Passion

## The Colorado Center on Law and Policy advances justice and economic security for all Coloradans through four core programs:

### Colorado Fiscal Policy Institute

- Pushing tax and budget reform efforts, such as the elimination of arbitrary limits on public investments.
- Safeguarding key programs that promote jobs and economic security.
- Advocating for transparency and accountability.

### Economic Self-Sufficiency

- Monitoring how the state and counties administer programs that advance economic security.

- Building partnerships with community organizations to lobby for legislation that promotes household economic security.

### Health Care

- Protecting the rights of participants in Colorado's public health insurance programs by ensuring the state complies with federal laws and regulations.
- Working at the legislature to expand access to health care, particularly for lower-income Coloradans.

### Litigation

- Filing suit to ensure the State of Colorado timely processes Medicaid, Child Health Plan Plus and food stamps applications.
- Identifying, and working with the state to correct, misinterpretations of federal law that interfere with access to public benefits.
